Robin Affrime has worked with CommuniCare Health Centers for 34 years, serving as the Chief Executive Officer for the past 19 years. Since starting with CommuniCare, Robin oversaw and guided the growth of the organization from a small free clinic run by volunteers to a Federally Qualified Health Center with three comprehensive primary care health centers and five satellite sites in Yolo County, providing services to nearly 27,000 people.

Today, CommuniCare is recognized as one of the leading community health centers in California. In 2008, the National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC) honored CommuniCare with the Migrant Health Center Outstanding Service Award, recognizing CommuniCare's excellence in the migrant health care field and the high level of commitment and innovation demonstrated in service to migrant and seasonal farm workers and their families.

Robin is an active leader in the region's community health networks, currently serving as President of the Board of Directors of the Redwood Community Health Coalition (RCHC), a member of the Strategic Planning Committee of Partnership Health Plan of California, and a member of the Board of Directors of the California Primary Care Association.

Robin earned a Master's in Public Health (MPH) from the University of Hawaii and is a graduate of the inaugural class of the Sierra Health Foundation Health Leadership Program. Robin's favorite award received was the "Safety Net Hero" Award, which was presented to her by the regional Serotonin Surge Charities.
