

## **Barbara Brandlin Hines**

A fifth-generation Californian, Barbara Brandlin Hines was born and raised in Los Angeles. She attended San Diego State University, where she earned a bachelor's degree in Business Management and the University of Southern California where she earned an MBA with an emphasis in accounting and finance. Prior to joining QueensCare, Ms. Hines was a Vice President in Commercial Banking at Wells Fargo Bank, N.A, responsible for financing middle market companies.

In 1993, after leaving banking to raise her two children, Ms. Hines was recruited to join the board of St. Joseph's Health Support Alliance, an affiliate of Queen of Angels-Hollywood Presbyterian Medical Center, as QueensCare was formerly known. She joined the hospital staff in 1997 as Vice President to establish its Charitable Division grantmaking program. She remained with QueensCare after the sale of the medical center, filling various executive administrative roles.

In 2009, Ms. Hines was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer of QueensCare, and QueensCare Health Centers, a partner organization of QueensCare. QueensCare Health Centers operates five federally qualified health centers in Los Angeles and shares QueensCare's mission of providing health care to low income residents. Ms. Hines served as Chief Executive Officer of QueensCare Health Center until her retirement from that role in December 2020, and continues to serve as President & CEO of QueensCare.
